Council Retreat – a successful Council Retreat was conducted SAT 4/9. Thank you to Dennis & Sue Zahrbock for allowing us to meet at their beautiful home.

- Council members are to <u>complete the Spiritual Gifts Test from *The 3 Colors of Ministry* by 4/25. Pastor Grant will lead further discussion at the May meeting.</u>
- John and Julie offered that we only heard half of the group's introductions at the meeting due to breaking out into two groups. Council agreed that we should share the introductions and spiritual gifts at the May meeting.
