A Message from Pastor Arthur



A New Year

One of the movies I love is *The Natural*. Released in 1984, it was directed by Barry Levinson. Robert Redford plays the role of Roy Hobbs. The movie is about a naturally gifted ball player whose life took a very different path. In the story, Hobbs lost his most productive ball playing years due to a violent incident, only to make his way to the majors

late in life and play for a last place team.

Near the end of the film, there is a wonderful line. Glenn Close plays the role of Iris Gaines, Hobbs' boyhood love. Hobbs finds himself in the hospital mourning the life that never unfolded in the way he so wanted. Gaines says to Hobbs, "You know, I believe we have two lives." Hobbs responds, "How, what do you mean?" To which Gaines replies, "The life we learn with and the life we live with after that." Gaines was reminding Hobbs that he couldn't control the events of his life, but he could control how he responds to them.

As 2023 unfolds, we will experience joy and sorrow. Many of these experiences will be out of our control. While this can make us feel powerless, we can control the attitude by which will face these experiences. We can either be cynical, expecting the worse and dwelling in negativity. This is the path of fear. Or we can be hopeful, expecting good outcomes, remaining positive no matter what we face. This is the path of faith.

In the gospel of St. Luke in the 13th chapter, Jesus told a parable that can be applied to this kind of thinking. "A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came looking for fruit on it and found none. So he said to the gardener, 'See here! For three years I have come looking for fruit on this fig tree, and still I find none. Cut it down! Why should it be wasting the soil?' He replied, 'Sir, let it alone for one more year, until I dig around it and put manure on it. If it bears fruit next year, well and good; but if not, you can cut it down.'"

Jesus is inviting us to cut out the negative thinking that clouds how we approach life. Such thinking never produces anything worthwhile. Conversely, Jesus is inviting to fertilize our lives with positive thinking which always produces fruit.

Just like last year, we will face days of joy and sorrow. In the face of such days, we have a choice to make. As your pastor, let me encourage you to reject the path of fear - that place where cynicism and negativity burn us up. Rather, embrace the path of faith - that place where hope and positive energy triumph. Happy New Year, everyone.

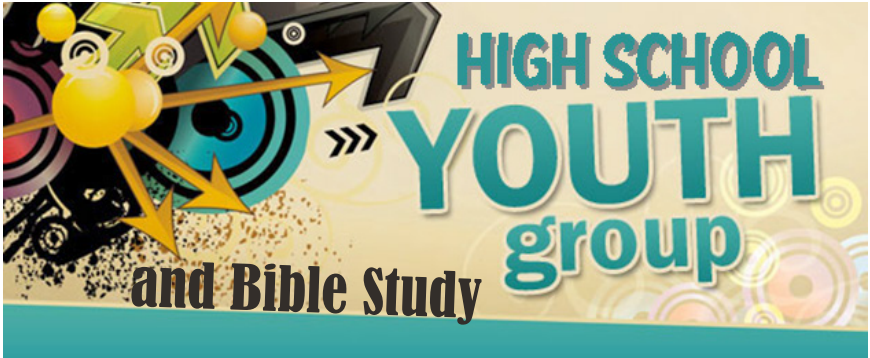
